DOGGYLAND LLC POLICIES, PROCEDURES AND RELEASE, WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT (“Agreement”)

In consideration for my dog being permitted to be a client at a DOGGYLAND LLC for boarding, I make the following representations and agree to all of the following policies, procedures, terms and conditions:

- 1. DOGGYLAND LLC REQUIREMENTS.** My dog meets the following requirements he/she: is four (4) months of age or older; he/she is spayed or neutered (if over six (6) months of age); is current on his/her Rabies, Distemper and Bordetella vaccinations; is in good general health and free of ticks and fleas; is not aggressive or protective of toys; meets all other municipal or state licensure and other requirements; is attending llc with a quick release collar
- 2. PERSONAL PROPERTY.** I agree that Doggyland Llc shall not be responsible or liable for any lost, stolen, or damaged personal property belonging either to me or my dog. I also understand and agree that my dog’s collar may be removed in the play area to prevent injury to any dog
- 3. AGGRESSIVE DOGS.** My dog is not aggressive. Although Doggyland Llc loves all dogs, I understand that aggressive dogs are not permitted to attend Doggyland Llc. If my dog acts aggressively or exhibits unacceptable behavior he/she may be separated from the other dogs. Doggyland Llc uses reasonable efforts to consult the dog’s owners about aggression and ways to address it, however aggressive dogs may be asked not to return to Doggyland Llc. Such determinations shall be made at the sole discretion of Doggyland Llc.
- 4. ABANDONED DOGS.** Doggyland Llc is a place where all dogs are loved and can romp and play. No dog may be abandoned at Doggyland Llc. I agree that I will not neglect to pick up my dog from Doggyland Llc by the time he/she is scheduled to leave without providing notification. Any dog that is left at Doggyland Llc without any contact, instruction or notification will be considered abandoned Doggyland Llc will, in its sole discretion, determine whether to try to re-home and adopt the dog from the Doggyland Llc or will relinquish the dog to an unrelated shelter of its choice. I FULLY UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THAT IF I ABANDON MY DOG AT DOGGYLAND LLC, I MAY BE UNABLE TO RETRIEVE POSSESSION OF MY DOG AND WILL HAVE NO RECOURSE AGAINST DOGGYLAND LLC..
- 5. DUTY TO DISCLOSE.** I have disclosed and shall continue to disclose on an ongoing basis, any and all medical or other conditions, including but not limited to personality concerns or behaviors that may affect, limit or prevent my dog’s ability to participate in play time or otherwise attend Doggyland Llc.
- 6. ACCEPTANCE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PARTICIPATION RISK.** I FULLY UNDERSTAND THAT: (a) THERE ARE INHERENT AND POTENTIAL RISKS INVOLVED WITH INTERACTIONS BETWEEN HUMANS AND DOGS, AS WELL AS BETWEEN DOGS AND OTHER DOGS, WHICH MAY RESULT IN PROPERTY DAMAGE OR BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PERMANENT DISABILITY, SICKNESS OR DEATH TO HUMAN OR DOG; AND (b) THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS NOT KNOWN TO ME NOR READILY FORESEEABLE AT THIS TIME (COLLECTIVELY, “RISKS”). I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL RISKS AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR ALL RISKS, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ALL LOSSES, COSTS AND DAMAGES INCURRED AS A RESULT OF MY OR MY DOG’S PARTICIPATION IN PLAY, INCLUDING ANY VETERINARIAN EXPENSES INCURRED ON BEHALF OF MY DOG. SICKNESS SHALL BE DEFINED TO INCLUDE ANY ILLNESS INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO BORDETELLA (KENNEL COUGH) OR ANY OTHER FORM OF CONTAGIOUS ILLNESS.
- 7. VETERINARIAN LIABILITY AND CARE.** I agree to allow Doggyland Llc to obtain medical treatment for my dog, if, in its sole discretion it appears that, he/she is ill, injured or exhibits any other behavior that would reasonably suggest that my dog may need medical treatment. I AGREE THAT I AM FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF ANY SUCH MEDICAL TREATMENT, AND FOR THE COST OF ANY TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUCH TREATMENT, PROVIDED TO MY DOG.
- 8. PHOTOS.** I agree to allow Doggyland to use photos they have taken of my dog, for advertising on the internet, print and television.
- 9. WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION.** I HEREBY EXPRESSLY WAIVE, DISCHARGE, INDEMNIFY, RELEASE FROM LIABILITY, SAVE, HOLD HARMLESS AND DEFEND DOGGYLAND LLC, AND THEIR INVITEES, SPONSORS, ADVERTISERS, MEMBERS, MANAGERS, OWNERS, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, INVITEES, AGENTS, AND ANY PARTIES OWNING, CONTROLLING OR HAVING ANY INTEREST IN DOGGYLAND LLC, AND ALL OTHER REPRESENTATIVES OR AGENTS (COLLECTIVELY “RELEASES”) FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL INJURY, LIABILITY, CLAIMS, LITIGATION, COSTS, LOSSES, DAMAGES, EXPENSES OR DEMANDS (INCLUDING REASONABLE ATTORNEY’S FEES) OF EVERY CHARACTER WHATSOEVER ON ACCOUNT OF, ARISING OUT OF, RESULTING FROM OR RELATING IN ANY WAY TO (I) ANY ACT OR OMISSION OF THE RELEASES’, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, AND (II) MY OR MY DOG’S PARTICIPATION IN BOARDING OR ACTIVITIES AT DOGGYLAND LLC, OR OTHERWISE. I AGREE THAT THIS RELEASE SHALL BE BINDING ON ME AND MY SUCCESSORS, HEIRS, LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES AND ASSIGNS. I ALSO EXPRESSLY AND FOREVER RELEASE DOGGYLAND LLC FROM ANY DUTY TO PROTECT ME OR MY DOG(S) FROM INJURY OF ANY KIND, AND AGREE THAT EVEN IF DOGGYLAND LLC CHOOSES TO IMPLEMENT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS, SUCH ACTIONS SHALL NOT ALTER THE FACT THAT I HAVE RELEASED DOGGYLAND LLC FROM ANY DUTY TO PROTECT ME OR MY DOG(S).

I HAVE READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT AND UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE OR GUARANTEE AND INTEND IT TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY PORTION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD TO BE INVALID OR UNENFORCEABLE, THAT THE REMAINDER OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT. I AGREE THAT IT IS INTENDED THAT ALL TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT CONTROL DESPITE ANY PARTICULAR STATUTE OR LAW THAT WOULD OTHERWISE PROTECT ME OR MY DOG(S).

COMMON VIRUSES AND INFECTIONS

Just like taking your child to daycare, your dog can get ill too. Even though we have an extremely clean environment, they can bring in infections from dog parks, other daycares, etc. By sharing the water and toys, it's inevitable that they may contract something.

The following are a list of common viruses and infections. It is important to know the symptoms and call us if you suspect they have something.

Bordetella – “The common cold”. Just because they've received the vaccination doesn't mean they still can't get the virus. Symptoms are a cough that won't stop, almost like something is stuck in their throat. Another common symptom is vomiting a foamy substance. Many dogs can get over the cold on their own without needing a veterinarian. Nevertheless, there are cases where it can turn into something else and antibiotics may be needed. For example pneumonia or bronchitis.

Influenza – “The Dog Flu”. Just because they've received the vaccination doesn't mean they still can't get the virus. Symptoms are throwing up, refusing to eat and/or drink, vomiting and diarrhea. It is imperative that they stay hydrated and nourished. If you suspect your dog has the flu, please call us as soon as possible. We have tips on how to get them to eat and drink.

Conjunctivitis – Is a green/yellow mucus discharge from the eye. Conjunctivitis is very common in daycare. There's plenty of dirty hair flying around and can get into your dog's eyes. They can't wipe their eyes like we can, so it can turn into an infection. We have eye drops (containing Boric Acid) that usually work if caught in the early stages. If not treated early enough, they will need to see a vet.

Giardia – A very common intestinal infection with dogs. One way of contracting it is by drinking out of a river or mud puddle. If you notice your dog experiencing diarrhea, greasy stool, bad gas or fowl belching or abdominal bloating, a vet check may be in order.
